

## National Weather Service MDL SCEP Program

The National Weather Service office in Silver Spring, MD is currently recruiting graduate and undergraduate students for the Student Career Experience Program, or SCEP. Applications are accepted throughout the year.

The MDL SCEP is a co-op program which offers undergraduate and graduate students majoring in computer science, mathematics, meteorology, oceanography, physics, and statistics an opportunity to alternate full-time paid employment with periods of full-time study. The full-time employment encompasses a total of 12 months at the National Weather Service (NWS) Meteorological Development Lab (MDL) in Silver Spring, Maryland. While there, students will develop and implement computer based scientific techniques and may participate in the development of statistical algorithms, analysis of meteorological data, verification of forecasts, and use of interactive graphics programs. Students should expect to make extensive use of computer technology and computer programming.
