Geography (GEOG) majors must complete six of the following courses within 30 attempted credits of entering the major:

+Must complete with a 'C' grade or higher: GEOG 201/211 or GEOG 202 and at least one other Geography course of your choice (except GEOG 100).

+Satisfactory completion of four CORE Distributive Studies courses which can include GEOG 201/211 and GEOG 202.

+Satisfactory completion of Math 110 or higher and English fundamental studies course requirements.

¹ GEOG 201 and 211 must be taken simultaneously to count for PL CORE

² Technical courses are usually not be applied to these requirements
